Registration for Summer 2022 and Fall 2022

Registration for both Summer and Fall 2022 are ongoing.

- Reach out to those who have not registered yet and refer to applicable support offices if needed (Financial Aid, Student Accounting, Student Success Center, etc.,)

Students Requesting Transfer credit/classes at other institutions

- Remind students to use the internal form: [Detroit-Mercy-Guest-Transfer-Credit-Request.pdf](#) located on the Registrar webpage. (Guest institutions may require additional forms).
- Senior Residency Rule: Candidates for a bachelor’s degree are to complete the last 30 credit hours of their program at University of Detroit Mercy. Any exceptions must be approved by the student’s dean’s office.

Transfer Credit Limits Apply:

Maximum **63** credits from community colleges (if a student has more, the most relevant credits will be used). Additional credits may transfer for Articulation Agreements.

Maximum **90-96** total transfer credits from 4-year universities (varies based on program).
