Summer Refunds and Withdrawals

Refund and withdrawal deadlines differ based on length of course. For example, notice that for Summer 1 and Summer 2, the last day to withdraw and receive full refund is the first day of class. Summer 3 courses are adjusted because it is a longer term. Many courses have different start and end dates that fall outside the general dates listed. Please refer to the Schedule of Classes for a particular semester to see the exact date to drop at 100% Refund and no "W" or last Day to Withdraw (with a "W") for your individual course section.
