Addiction Studies majors can add a Leadership Minor by taking only one additional class if you take LEAD 2000 to count for IT5 and IT6—the Leadership Capstone class. The skills learned in the leadership program augment the kinds of things you will learn in your major and help you be successful in doing real world work. If you play your cards right, Addiction Studies majors can even double minor!

3. Organizational Management & Human Relations Skills	ADS 4360 – Family Theory and Therapy or ADS 4440 – Advanced Internship <i>(Either of these will count for your major <u>and</u> the minor)</i>
4. Community Engagement Skills	ADS 4170 – Substance Use Disorders in Youth or ADS 4500 – Prevention and Intervention of Substance Abuse <i>(Either of these will count for your major <u>and</u> the minor)</i>
Leadership Capstone	LEAD 4000 or PYC 4620 (3 cr.)
