Introductory Course	LEAD 2000 [IT5 & IT6]
<p>Theatre majors can add a Leadership Minor by taking the Introductory and Capstone classes. The Introductory class also counts as IT5 and IT6, so it's usually only one extra class! The skills learned in the leadership program augment what you learn in your major and help you be successful in doing real world work. You can even double minor with Theatre as your major!</p>	
1. Individual Leadership Skills	<p>PHL 2010 – Foundations of Ethics [F1] (Counts for the university core <u>and</u> the minor)</p>
2. Group Skills	<p>Pick one: GEO 2110 – World Regional Geography [C2] [IT4] SOC 1000 – Sociology [C2] PYC 2600 – Social Psychology [C2] (Counts for the university core <u>and</u> the minor)</p>
3. Organizational Management & Human Relations Skills	<p>TRE 3060 – Principles of Arts Management (Counts for your major <u>and</u> the minor)</p>
4. Community Engagement Skills	<p>TRE 2700 – Theatre for Social Change (Counts for your major <u>and</u> the minor)</p>
Possible Addition if Needed	<p>TRE 1500 – Human Expression counts for the Leadership Minor under Category 2 “Group Skills” but we can only use two courses from your major to your minor. If you DO use TRE 1500 for C2, we will find something else for C4.</p>
Final Leadership Capstone	LEAD 4000 or PYC 4620 (3 cr.)
