PRE-DENTAL AND PRE-MEDICAL PROGRAMS

The following courses will transfer into Detroit Mercy to satisfy many of the course requirements for application to dental, medical, PA and other Pre-Health graduate/professional schools. Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits toward a Bachelor's Degree. Course grades must be a C or better. Additional courses not on this guide may also transfer. **Students are encouraged to also obtain a Transfer Guide for their chosen undergraduate major** (many are available on Detroit Mercy's website – Biology, Chemistry/Biochemistry, etc).

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 2.50 GPA based on 24 or more credits earned at Mott CC (and/or other accredited institutions).
- If less than 24 credits have been earned, a student's high school transcript is required.
- Apply for admission to Detroit Mercy at udmercy.edu/apply; the application is free.

Students should review the admission requirements of their prospective dental, medical, PA and other Pre-Health graduate/professional schools for a complete list of required coursework. Note: many dental and medical school admission committees prefer science courses be taken at a four-year institution.
